Contest Rules and Guidelines

#### I. QUALIFICATION

- 1. The contest is **Open to Siday Enthusiast-Elementary Division** in the Municipality of Palo.
- 2. An Accomplished Entry Forms and Entry piece must be submitted to the Palo Tourism, Culture, Arts & Media Office not later than July 7, 2023, until 5:00 PM Only.
- All competing individuals must abide by the Contest Rules and Guidelines herein specified and such other that may be implemented.

### I. SPECIFIC RULES

- We will be accepting Twenty (25) entries only for the Write-Up Category. First-Come, First-Served basis only.
- 2. Only Twelve (12) entries will qualify for the Final Competition.
- 3. Only one (1) entry must consist of one (1) poem.
- 4. Only Unpublished works are eligible. A work that has been awarded a prize in another contest is not qualified for the Contest.
- 5. All entries should be written originally in WARAY and not a translation of a work written in another language. The piece must reflect this year's theme "Patron ha Palo".
- 6. Entries must be submitted in two (2) copies, double-spaced, on short or long bond paper.
- 7. Entries must be submitted on or before July 3, 2023, with a pseudonym only not the author's real name. The author's name, pseudonym, and contact number must be submitted to the Palo Tourism Culture Arts & Media office. There will be no extension of the submission dates. The schedule for prejudging the piece will be on July 12, 2023. The Organizers will send a text message as soon as possible if the entry is qualified or not for the final competition.
- 8. A Siday interpreter must attend the three-day workshop hosted by the Palo LGU on July 27, 28, and 29, from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm at the Palo Municipal Building's second-floor function hall (lobby area). The competition will be on July 30, 2023, at 8:00 pm at the Palo Pag-ibig Plaza.
- 9. The rules and guidelines for this contest, as well as the prizes, are subject to change as circumstances dictate, with proper notice to contestants.
- 10. The Decision of the Board of Judges shall be deemed final and irrevocable.
