**KITE FLYING COMPETITION
(INDIVIDUAL AND FAMILY CATEGORY)**

I. GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

1. PARTICIPANTS

This competition is open to everyone who has the passion in kite building and flying. A participant should only have one entry. Only one runner is recommended per entry and a kite pilot.

2. MATERIALS

The size of the kite must be a **10 square feet** with a kite string of **100 meters long**. It must be original and never been used in any previous competitions. Participants may choose any materials such as paper or cloth or a combination of these while the kite frame could be made of wood or bamboo. Commercial kite is not eligible for competition.

3. RELEVANCE

The kite design must highlight the theme of **PAGBALIK HA PALO 2023: PAGPUPUGAY SA KAGITINGAN AT KABAYANIHAN NG MGA BETERANONG PILIPINO**". All entries should not contain in any material that is offensive or disgraceful towards any person, profession or community.

4. TIME DURATION

The kite pilots shall be given a 5-minute launch period and a retry for every failure to take-off. A kite that gets entangled may be flown again with clearance from the organizers.

II. TIMELINE

1. Submission of Entries

- a) Free registration. Open to everyone. Contestants must register before the contest and display their number at all times.
Contestants may enter only one kite. (One kite, one contestant)
- b) Deadline for submission of entries is **October 7, 2023 (5:00 PM)** at Palo Tourism, Culture, Arts and Media Office or thru email at palotourism@gmail.com.

2. Judging

The competition will be on **October 16, 2023 at 9:00 AM**. The decision of the Board of Judges is **FINAL AND IRREVOCABLE**.

3. Awarding

All winning entries shall become a property of LGU-Palo. Awarding will be done on **October 16, 2023 at 7:00 PM** in Palo Pag-ibig Plaza.

III. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

Kite Size- Square footage of the sail area will determine the size of the kite.	30%
Visual appeal	<u>20%</u>
