EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. Series of 2020

"AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PALO, LEYTE

WHEREAS, Philippine Constitution mandates the State to uphold the protection and promotion of the rights of all citizens to quality education at all levels and take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all;

WHEREAS, Republic Act 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides for the establishment of a Local School Board in every local government unit;

WHEREAS, in view of the recent local elections resulting in the change of administration and end of the term of some of the members thereof, there is a need to reconstitute the Local School Board of the Municipality of Palo,

NOW THEREFORE, I, FRANCES ANN B. PETILLA, Municipal Mayor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby reconstitute the Local School Board of the Municipality of Palo, Leyte:

Section 1. Composition. The Local School Board shall be composed of the following:

Section 2. Functions. The Municipal School Board shall perform the following:

- a.) Determine, in accordance with the criteria set by the Department of Education, Culture and Sports, the annual supplementary budgetary needs for the operation and maintenance of public schools within the province, city or municipality, as the case may be, and the supplementary local cost of meeting such needs, which shall be reflected in the form of an annual school board budget corresponding to its share in the proceeds of the special levy on real property constituting the Special Education fund and such other sources of revenue as this Code and other laws or ordinances may provide;
- b.) Authorize the provincial, city or municipal treasurer, as the case may be, to disburse funds from the Special Education fund pursuant to the budget prepared and in accordance with existing rules and regulations;
- c.) Serve as an advisory committee to the Sanggunian concerned on educational matters such as, but not limited to, the necessity for and the uses of local appropriations for educational purposes; and
- d.) Recommend changes in the names of public schools within the territorial jurisdiction of the local government unit for enactment by the Sanggunian concerned.

Section 3. Meetings. The local school board shall meet at least once a month or as often as may be necessary.

Section 4. Repealing Clause. All orders, issuances, rules and regulations or parts thereof inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 5. Effectivity. This Order shall take effect immediately.
